

# **Guide for Academic Mentors in Ireland 2017**

This document is provided to assist you in submitting an Academic Mentor's Form for applications under the 2017 Irish Research Council Enterprise Partnership Scheme Postdoctoral Fellowship Scheme.

The deadline for submitting your Mentor Form is exactly:

16:00 (Ireland time), 15th June 2017

The Irish Research Council will only accept references through the online application system, as explained below. Please do not send any hard copies of your Academic Mentor Form to the Irish Research Council.

Please read this document carefully prior to completing the form.

# Logging on to the system

Please note that the online system can only be successfully accessed and supported through the following browsers: <u>Internet Explorer</u> (version 7 and higher), <u>FireFox</u> (2 most recent versions), <u>Google Chrome</u> (2 most recent versions) or <u>Safari</u> (2 most recent versions).

Ensure that the email address <u>ircapps@research.ie</u> is on your 'safe senders' list. You may need to check with your IT department to ensure there is no issue with your organisation's internal firewall.

When you were initially registered as a Mentor, you should have received an email containing your username (i.e. your email address) and password, and a link to the login page: <u>https://irishresearch.smartsimple.ie/s\_Login.jsp</u>

If you have mislaid your password or the email with the password, then enter the above URL and click on the 'Forgot password?' link. A system-generated password will be forwarded to your email address.

When you log in to the system, the following screen will be displayed:



You will not be able to provide your Mentor form until the applicant has submitted their application. However, you can preview the application details by (a) clicking on the 'Preview Applications in Draft Status' icon on the home page and then (b) clicking on the 'Print (PDF)' button on the following 'My Assigned Applications in Draft' screen.



To create your Mentor form, click on the 'Academic Mentor in Ireland assigned Postdoctoral Applications' icon that is on the 'Home' screen.



# **Completing the Mentor form**

Once the 'Academic Mentor in Ireland Assigned Postdoctoral Applications' has been clicked the following window will appear. The application may be viewed under 'Print(PDF)' and the Mentor form may be created by clicking on 'Create'



Once you have created your form, you can log out and back in as many times as you want (up until the deadline) and edit the form by simply clicking on **Edit**. Ensure you **'Save'** throughout the process.

Your data can be saved by clicking on the **Save Draft** button at the bottom left of the screen. Do not click away to another tab or desktop until information has been saved, as you may lose information otherwise

### **IMPORTANT: Submitting the form**

To finally submit the form you must:

Open your Mentor Form. Check you are satisfied with the information you have inputted and then click the **Submit** button at the bottom of the screen.

#### Save and press submit when the form is complete.



The following box will appear. If you are happy with the content of the form, **click OK.** Note: Once you submit your form there will be no further changes permitted so please ensure you are satisfied with all the content of the form before you click 'Submit' and 'OK'.
